The meeting will begin at 17:30, for a 18:00 start. Meetings are open to all, you do not need to be a member of SaRS to attend. **Book here to attend the event:**

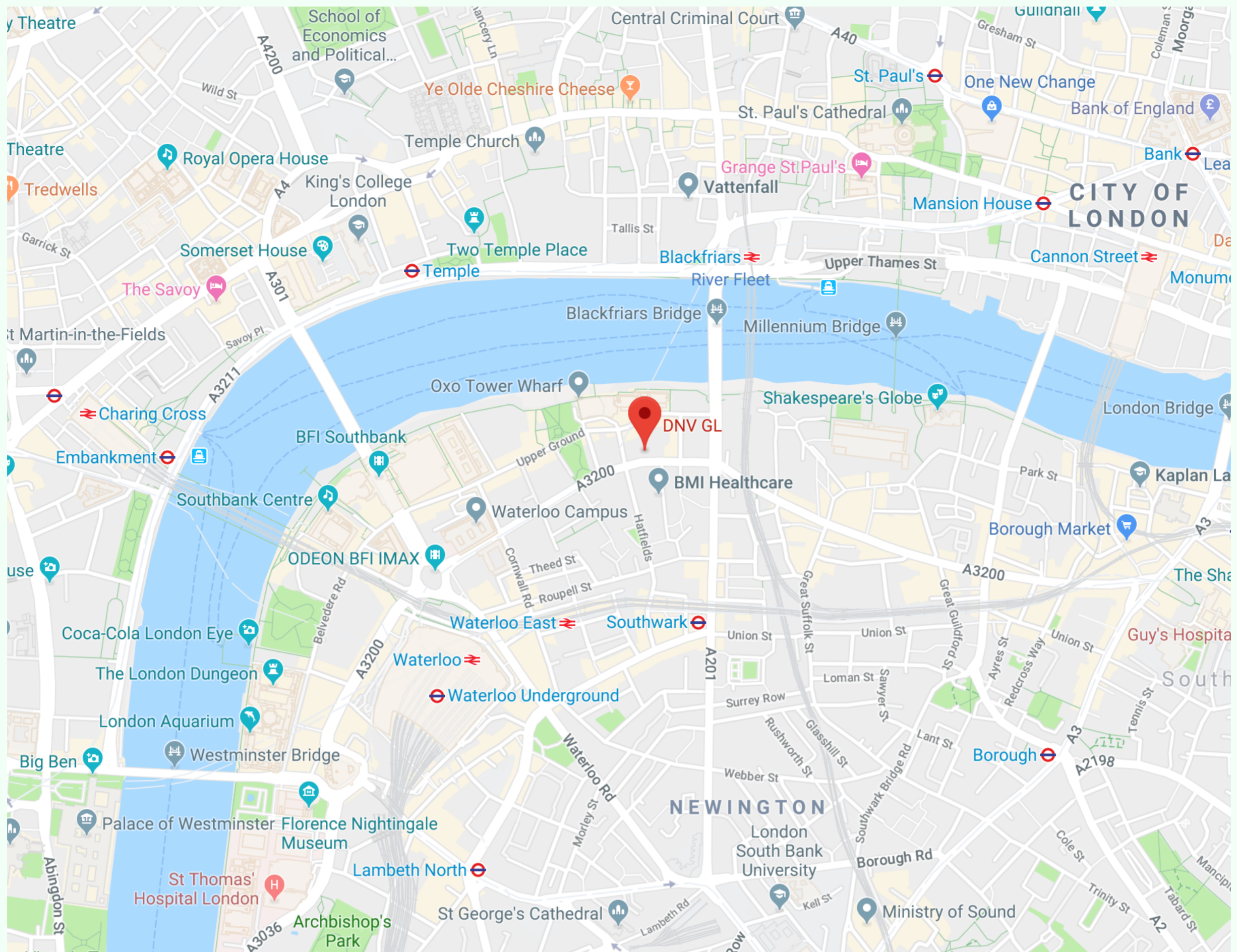
