
## SaRS SAFETY AND RELIABILITY SOCIETY

Using Discrete Event Simulation to Reduce the Impact of Poor Reliability, presented by James Ibbitson of BMT APL 6:30pm, Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup> April 2018, at BMT APL, Whiteley, PO15 7AH



Discrete event simulation is the process of modelling the behaviour of a network of systems (or processes) as a sequence of well-defined events. This presentation will provide an introduction to discrete event modelling and explore its application within the R&M and Safety domain including considerations for modelling constraints and dependencies such as resource availability, spares holdings and logistic travel times.

**The Presenter:** James is an award winning graduate from the University of Sheffield, graduating in 2011 with a 1st Class honours degree in Mechanical Engineering. He undertook a two year graduate scheme at Agusta Westland where he was involved in manufacturing operations, flight test data acquisition/analysis and production line modelling. Since 2013 James has been working for BMT as a consultant with a growing expertise in numerous engineering disciplines including Reliability & Maintainability and Integrated Logistic Support.
