Visit to Southampton SEACITY Museum 2:00 to 5:00pm, Tuesday 19th September 2017



SaRS Solent branch has organised a group visit to Southampton's SeaCity Museum which showcases a huge range of interesting artefacts sourced from the city's maritime, archives, archaeology and local collections. This visit is open to all SaRS members and "would-be" SaRS members in the Solent area.

The main area of the Museum tells the story of the impact on Southampton of the sinking in 1912 of the White Star liner Titanic. Through a fascinating 1:25 scale, interactive model of the ship, visitors are given an insight into the lives of the crew aboard the Titanic, many of whom were Southampton residents.

Southampton has a reputation of being the "Gateway to the World": Using the city's unique historic collections this permanent display recounts the stories of people who have departed from or arrived in the port of Southampton over 200,000 years, from the earliest settlers to the stories of people living in the city today.
