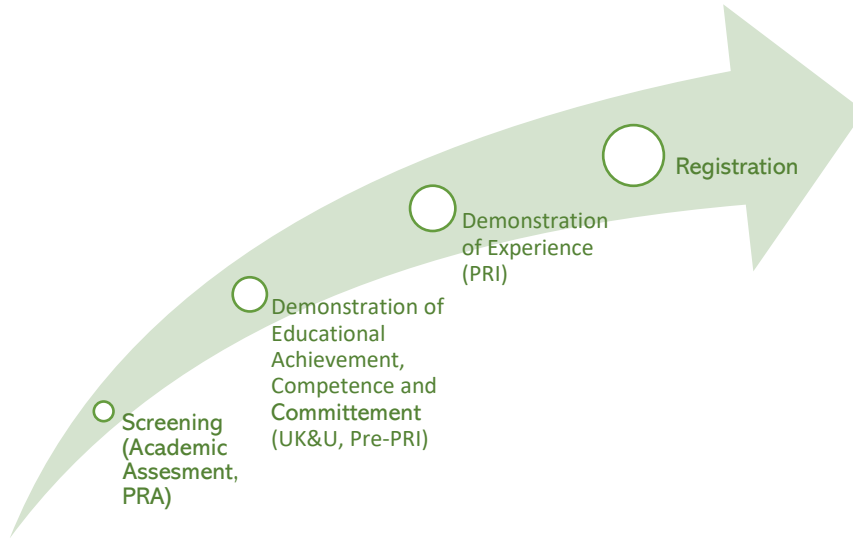

Engineering Council Registration - what happens after submitting your application?



Screening—At the screening stage our experts will identify the most suitable route for you. This includes:

Academic Assessment—the Academic Assessment Committee (AAC) will check your qualifications. Depending on your academic background and the register you are applying to join (IEng/CEng) you may already clearly demonstrate this and proceed along our **Standard** route to registration. Alternatively, we may need to work with you to demonstrate how you meet the educational requirements along with competence and commitment on our **Individual** route to registration.

Professional Review Advisor (PRA)—Following initial screening, we will offer you the assistance of an advisor trained to help you identify the elements of your competency, commitment, and education to date which demonstrate the various criteria. All applicants may have three rounds of PRA if they request.

Following successful completion of the above, we will ask you to prepare your final application form to go forward for Professional Review.

Professional Review

Demonstration of Educational Achievement and Experience—our pre-professional review interview (Pre-PRI) assessors will formally look at the underpinning knowledge and understanding (UK&U) in terms of your educational achievements and your demonstration of competence and commitment. They will review these together to understand if they fit the criteria for the registration you have applied for. If not, we may ask you to produce more evidence such as an academic transcript or a formal report which demonstrates that you have gained the knowledge required for the register.

Professional Review Interview

Following success at the Pre-PRI, we will invite you to a formal professional review interview (PRI) by peers who will assess that your experience meets the requirements of the register.

If you successfully complete the interview, we will add you to the appropriate register.

What we do

In the background we undertake various additional activities:

After the interview we independently review all the information generated to ensure that the recommendation following the interview is reasonable and that we have followed our process (Post-PRI)

We train our assessors in the review process

We hold regular meetings to review our registration process and applications

We are continuously working with the Engineering Council to provide best practice

Payment

Of course, at various points we need to ask you for payment:

- On application we will ask for payment for the process
- After a successful interview we will ask for payment of Engineering Council registration fees
- And during the process we will check that you are a paid-up member of SaRS
